



A few have eyes to see in back of these developments, to the squatter communities, the homeless, the unemployed, and the street children at risk of repeating the difficult lives of their parents in grinding poverty. The ATS Transformational Urban Leadership program sharpens the concepts, attitudes and skills needed to uplift poor communities both spiritually and materially. Connecting to the poor

The Transformational Urban Leadership program is designed for Christian practitioners among the urban poor. Bringing together a team of national and international experts we promote the best practices in ministry among the urban poor. Guided by a foundation of Bible, evangelical theology, and applied social sciences, studies include such areas as holistic church planting, community development, ministry to prostitutes and street children, starting preschools, primary health care, advocacy and environmental issues among the poor.

Burnout is a significant problem among urban workers so we seek to nurture a resilient urban spirituality in participants. We also recognize that ministry among the urban poor is something that cannot be learned only in the classroom, so we emphasize experiential learning by connecting the classroom to marginalized urban peoples.

The Center for Transformational Urban Leadership

(CTUL) trains people to address the needs of the two billion slum dwellers who will inhabit cities globally by 2030. Today there are three million squatters in Metro Manila living along sidewalks, under bridges, riverbanks, esteros and in garbage dumps.

Who is qualified?

Those holding an undergraduate degree are qualified for the Graduate Diploma and Master of Arts in Transformational Urban Leadership. Those with some college and who are at least 35 years old can enter the Diploma in Transformational Urban Leadership Program.

What is the schedule?

Registration and classes begin in June and October. Check our website for semestral courses and intersemestral and summer modules.

What are the costs per unit?
